What's flowering in Trayning Shire in August/ September

Common Firebush, (Keraudrenia integrefolia) rounded shrub to 1.5 m, very colourful purple flowers often along roadsides esp. in sand or gravel.



Yellow Feather-flower, (Verticordia chrysantha) to about .5m, found around the base of granites or on sandy gravelly soils.



Rock Buttercup (Hibertia rubicola) shrub on gravel or granite soils.

Pink Everlasting (Schoenia cassiniana), annual to 40cm, pink flowers fade to white with age -sandy soil in open woodland




Bottlebrush Grevillia (Grevillia paradoxa) 1-2m shrub on gravel or granite soils
