

What's flowering in Trayning Shire in August/ September

Common Firebush, (*Keraudrenia integrefolia*) rounded shrub to 1.5 m, very colourful purple flowers often along roadsides esp. in sand or gravel.



Yellow Feather-flower, (*Verticordia chrysantha*) to about .5m, found around the base of granites or on sandy gravelly soils.



Rock Buttercup (*Hibertia rubicola*) shrub on gravel or granite soils.

Pink Everlasting (*Schoenia cassiniana*), annual to 40cm, pink flowers fade to white with age -sandy soil in open woodland



Bottlebrush Grevillia (*Grevillia paradoxa*) 1-2m shrub on gravel or granite soils



Emu Bush (*Hakea francisiana*) Shrub or small tree to 8m on sand or gravel.



Flame Grevillea (Grevillea excelsior) Small pine like tree in sandy loam and kwongan
