



Election Gifts

Established and maintained under Regulation 30G of the Local Government (Election) Regulations 1997

The Chief Executive Officer is required to keep a record of the disclosures by way of a register, which is to be published on the Shire's website, as well as made available for public inspection at the Shire's Administration Building.

*** Please note: under the Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997, it is an offence to publish information in certain cases –

(1) A person must not publish —

(a) any information derived from an electoral gift register unless that information constitutes a fair or accurate report or summary of information contained in the register and is published in good faith; or

(b) any comment on the facts set forth in an electoral gift register unless that comment is fair and published in good faith.
