### What do we need to focus on improving?

Our biggest priority for improvement remains our rural roads with the roads being identified as one of our top 5 most important services we provide and one of the areas of least satisfaction.

### Satisfaction with the Shire/Services

All categories received significantly more positive than negative responses.

### Our biggest issues in next 5-10 years

1. Maintaining numbers at the local Primary School
2. Losing health services
3. Lack of services from local businesses
4. Maintaining population
5. Employment opportunities for young people

The majority of people thought that the Shire should incentivise new business/services and would be willing to pay more for improvements. The majority of respondents were women who lived in the Trayning townsite or rural properties, owned the property they lived in and were over 60 years of age.

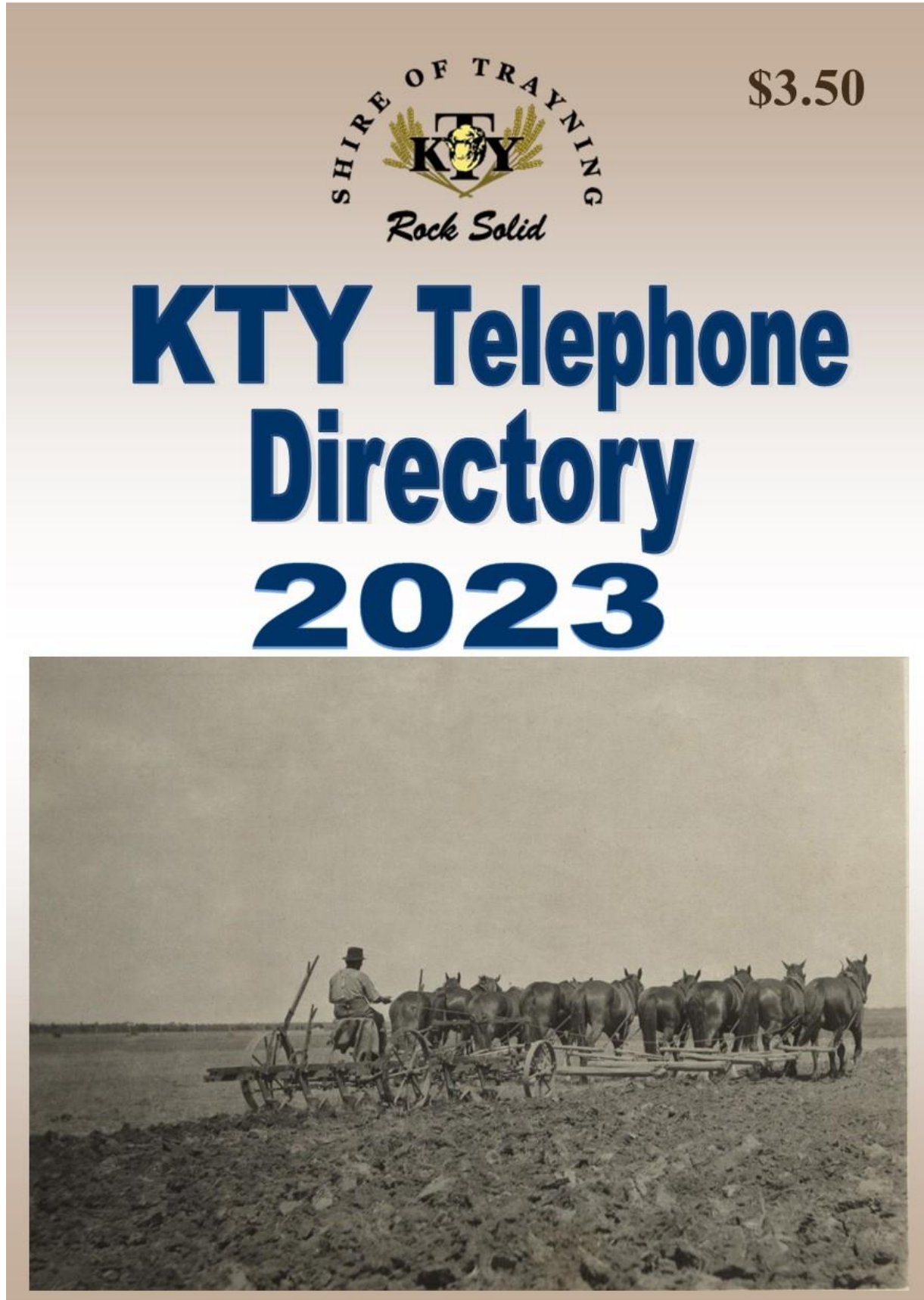

## Pulse oximeter What you need to know!

COVID-19

- ☐ Are you non-Aboriginal and over 65?
- ☐ Are you Aboriginal and over 50?
- ☐ Are you pregnant?



If you answered YES to any of the above – collect a free pulse oximeter from your local government today!

### What is a pulse oximeter?

It is a small, peg-like device that clips onto your fingertip to read your heart rate and blood oxygen level. It takes only one minute to work, is reusable and can be shared between other people in your household.



### Why do I need one?

If you become COVID-19 positive, you may need to be remotely monitored through the WA COVID Care at Home program. By having a pulse oximeter already in your home, a health professional can assess you and provide health advice from the comfort of your home.

### Where do I get one?

Visit your local government to collect a free pulse oximeter for you and your household (each eligible household can receive one pulse oximeter but supplies are limited).

Do **not** pick up a pulse oximeter if you are already COVID-19 positive. If you have already received a positive COVID-19 test result, the Department of Health will contact you and provide further information.

### SMALL COMMUNITY GRANTS NOW OPEN

4 May 2023

The latest round of *Mia's Local Hero Grants*, a small grants program to help support local community groups across the Central Wheatbelt electorate is now open for applications.

Ms Davies said that in her role as the local State Member of Parliament she was pleased to support groups with the program offering small but meaningful grants to community and not-for-profit groups in the electorate.

"My latest *Mia's Local Hero Grants* program will provide amounts of up to \$200 for local groups who support and enrich the community they serve", Ms Davies said.

"This grant round is now open, and I'd encourage all eligible groups to make an application."

"The funds could be used to support or sponsor a local event, contribute toward the purchase of new equipment or materials, or to assist your group to better support your members or community."

Ms Davies said the grants provided an opportunity to show her support, thanks and appreciation for the hardworking volunteer and not-for-profit organisations that make such a difference in our community.

"The application process isn't onerous, but it is competitive so make sure you explain clearly how the money will be used and why it will benefit the community or people you support," she said.

"I'm looking forward to receiving the applications, and if anyone has concerns about their eligibility, they should contact my office."

This will be the 7<sup>th</sup> round of *Mia's Local Hero Grants*.

"I'm pleased to have delivered over \$45,000 in grant funding for 220 separate grants – going to groups in every Shire of the electorate of Central Wheatbelt," Ms Davies said.

Round 7 opens Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and closes at 4.00pm on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

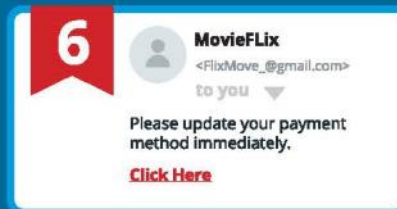

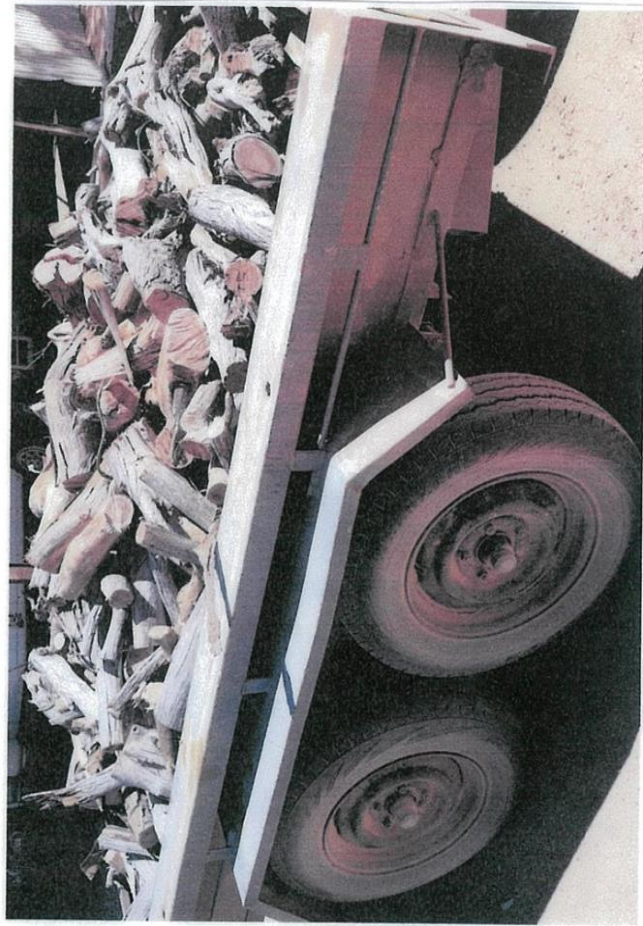

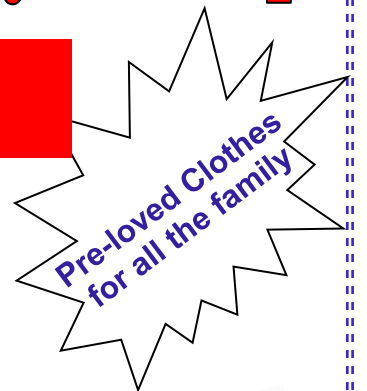
