

Managers' report June Council Meeting

The manager of works is currently working on budgeting for capital works. This year we will be focusing on reseals and the construction of Perks Omeara to Yelbeni Kelleberrin road. Maintenance grading is continuing in zone 1 the works team will be in this area for at least the next 4 weeks. The manager of works will be conducting some trials on Fleming Road using different types of materials through the salt plains we will be trialing a range of blue metal and some polymers to see which is more effective.

SLK 3.83 to SLK 4.82	Deep fill blend of crushed rock and crushed dust
SLK 6.35 to SLK 7.35	Std Gravel
SLK 7.35 to SLK 8.35	14/20 mm Aggregate Blend
SLK 8.35 to SLK 9.35	Deep fill crushed rock and crusher dust
SLK 9.35 to SLK 10.35	Clay Crete polymer blend

The purpose of the trial is to try and neutralize the clay content in the gravel especially in the salt plain areas where the roads surface gets very slippery the works manager will inspect weekly and report back to council in this report monthly.

First Responders Day

Council outdoor staff were invited to the primary school for the first responders' day this was very well attended by Police St Johns DEFAS and the shire. The outdoor staff took over the loader and skid steer the students asked a lot of questions and enjoyed the day.

Works Team

Roads completed are McAndrew Road Wallambin Road Nalkaln and Flemming Road to Gabbin Trayning Road. The grading crew is working hard to ensure that the crown is brought back into the road and drainage is reestablished. The skid steer is working ahead of the grader trying to get vegetation back under control. Currently the grading crew are doing about 4ks per day concentration on Quality rather than quantity.

Parks and Gardens

The team are continuing maintenance on the school oval caravan park and main street as well as work in Kununoppin. We are ensuring that the spraying program continues on days that weather will allow us to. The parks team have both been in training and have completed safe operations of chainsaw.
