



Manager of Works Report

- All the capital projects are now complete.
- The Kununoppin- Mukinbudin Road was sealed on 5th May. The works team will have finished the clean up and guide post installation by the 15th May.
- We are still experiencing higher than average fuel costs and this is being monitored.
- Cenitaphs were cleaned up in preparation for this year's ANZAC day service, positive feedback was received from members of the community.
- Maintenance grading will commence in zone 1 as of the 13th May, the grading program will start from with the Mount Marshall boundary on the Gabbin-Trayning Road.
- As stated in the Council forum rather than just doing gravel resheeting next year the grading team will be focused on a more proactive approach in maintenance grading with material being brought onsite as required to fix problem areas.

Works Team

- Maintenance grading will start in zone 1 which is in the North Yelbeni area and then move across to zone 2 South Yelbeni.
- Plant used will be grader, roller, water truck, side tipper and loader, Works will start on the Gabbin-Trayning Road and Swampwell Road.
- Roadside slashing has commenced with main areas of focus being the Kununoppin-Mukinbudin Road and Bencubin-Kellerberrin Road, once that is completed the skid steer and mulcher will start working in zone 1 then move across to zone 2. Given the amount of roadside vegetation this will take some years to complete.

Parks

- Parks team are continuing to bring open space areas up to a standard that the community expects.
- Focus areas this month will be irrigation in the main open space areas, the Doctor's premises in Kununoppin, weekly mowing of the school oval, and Pioneer Park.

- Spraying will continue in Trayning and Kununoppin as weather permits, the team will also be in Trayning for three days doing chainsaw course.
